

Q1: Depth and Contents of Syllabus 88 responses




### Depth and Contents of Syllabus (Q1)

- Analysis:
  - $\circ$  50% of students rated the depth and content of the syllabus as excellent.
  - $\circ$  30% rated it as good.
  - $\circ$  15% rated it as average.
  - 5% rated it as poor.



• **Interpretation:** The majority of students (80%) find the syllabus to be detailed and comprehensive, though 20% see room for improvement.

### Size of Syllabus in Terms of Load on Students (Q2)

- Analysis:
  - 40% of students find the syllabus load manageable.
  - 35% find it slightly heavy.
  - $\circ$  20% find it heavy.
  - 5% find it very heavy.
  - **Interpretation:** While 40% of students are comfortable with the workload, 60% feel it is somewhat to very heavy, indicating a need for balancing the workload.


Q3: Relevance of theory syllabus with practical/lab work 88 responses




### Relevance of Theory Syllabus with Practical/Lab Work (Q3)

- **Interpretation:** A significant majority (85%) see a good connection between theory and practical work, though 15% feel this could be improved.




Q4: Connectivity with preceding year syllabus 88 responses



### **Connectivity with Preceding Year Syllabus (Q4)**


- Analysis:

  - **Interpretation:** Most students (85%) feel the syllabus builds well on previous knowledge, with 15% seeing some gaps.


Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 88 responses

  - Interpretation: The distribution of teaching hours is largely satisfactory (80%), but there is a 20% segment that suggests potential for better allocation.






### Caters to the Needs of Students in the Subject (Q6)

  - **Interpretation:** A high percentage (85%) of students feel their academic needs are met by the curriculum, with a small portion (15%) indicating room for improvement.


Q7: Provides foundation for higher studies 88 responses




### **Provides Foundation for Higher Studies (Q7)**

Interpretation: A significant majority (85%) believe the curriculum prepares them well for higher studies, though 15% suggest enhancements could be made




Q8: Inculcates employabiltiy skills among students 88 responses



### Inculcates Employability Skills Among Students (Q8)


- Analysis:

  - **Interpretation:** A large majority (85%) feel that the curriculum promotes social responsibility, though 15% think there could be improvements.




#### **Inculcates Research Ambiance Among Students (Q10)**




Q2: Size of Syllabus in terms of load on the student 14 responses







Q3: Relevance of theory syllabus with practical/lab work 14 responses




Q4: Connectivity with preceding year syllabus 14 responses




Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 14 responses











Q8: Inculcates employability skills among students 14 responses



# **Question-wise Analysis**

#### 1. Depth and Contents of Syllabus

• **Analysis**: The majority of students felt that the syllabus covered the essential topics in depth. However, some students suggested including more contemporary topics to stay current with advancements in the field.

### 2. Size of Syllabus in terms of Load on the Student

• Analysis: Students indicated that the syllabus was moderately heavy. They felt the workload was manageable but suggested a slight reduction in certain areas to alleviate pressure during exam periods.

- 3. Relevance of Theory Syllabus with Practical/Lab Work
  - Analysis: There was a positive response regarding the alignment of theory with practical work. Some students recommended increasing the number of practical sessions for better understanding.
- 4. Connectivity with Preceding Year Syllabus
  - Analysis: Students generally found good connectivity with previous years' syllabi. A few noted gaps in specific subjects, suggesting a more structured transition between courses.

## 5. Distribution of the Teaching Hours among Course Components

• Analysis: Feedback indicated that teaching hours were well-distributed among course components. Some students proposed increasing hours for more complex topics to ensure thorough understanding.

## 6. Caters to the Needs of the Students in the Subject

• Analysis: Most students agreed that the curriculum catered to their academic needs. Suggestions included incorporating more diverse teaching materials and methodologies.

## 7. Provides Foundation for Higher Studies

• Analysis: Students felt that the curriculum provided a strong foundation for higher studies. They recommended adding more advanced topics to prepare for specialized postgraduate courses.

### 8. Inculcates Employability Skills among Students

• Analysis: There was a mixed response regarding employability skills. Some students felt well-prepared, while others suggested integrating more industry-relevant skills and training sessions.


### 9. Promotes Social Responsibility among Students




# Q2: Size of Syllabus in terms of load on the student 19 responses



Q1: Depth and Contents of Syllabus 17 responses






Q2: Size of Syllabus in terms of load on the student 17 responses









Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 17 responses

















Q1: Depth and Contents of Syllabus 16 responses




Q2: Size of Syllabus in terms of load on the student 16 responses











Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 16 responses








# Analysis of Teacher Feedback on Curriculum for the Year 2023-24 Questions and Feedback


















Q10: Inculcates research ambiance among students <sup>6</sup> responses


















Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 9 responses











Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component <sup>6</sup> responses













# Q3: Relevance of theory syllabus with practical/lab work <sup>2</sup> responses






Q4: Connectivity with preceding year syllabus 2 responses




Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component <sup>2</sup> responses












Q8: Inculcates employabiltiy skills among students 2 responses



## **Question-wise Feedback Analysis**

#### 3. Relevance of Theory Syllabus with Practical/Lab Work









Q2: Size of Syllabus in terms of load on the student 40 responses




Q3: Relevance of theory syllabus with practical/lab work 40 responses




Q4: Connectivity with preceding year syllabus 40 responses







Q5: Distribution of the teaching hours among course component 40 responses




Q6: Caters to the needs of the students in the subject 40 responses









Q8: Inculcates employability skills among students 40 responses




Q9: Promotes social responsibility among students 40 responses




