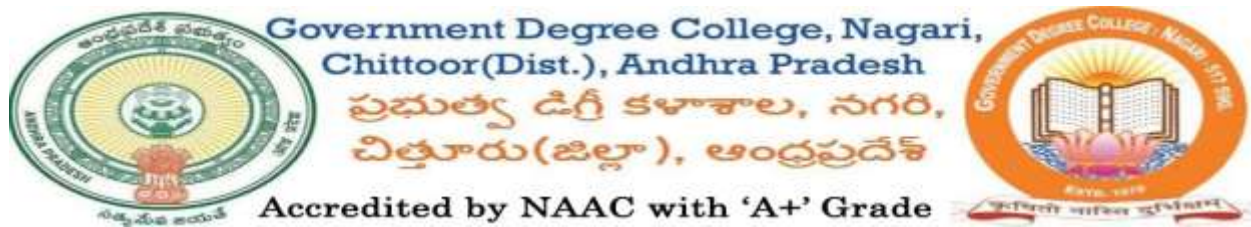

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)


The IQAC at Government Degree College, Nagari plays a key role in preparing and monitoring the academic timetable, addressing any deviations with concerned departments. Result analysis and feedback from students are integral to the review process, with outcomes discussed with faculty members to improve teaching methods.

The college has developed one virtual classroom and three digital classrooms to integrate modern teaching methods. Communication between students, teachers, and stakeholders is strengthened through the institutional website and emails. Additionally, video lectures via LMS are provided for student benefit.


ICT-based teaching is widely implemented, with over 50% of the syllabus covered through digital methods. Teachers use graphical images, animations, demonstration videos, and video lectures in daily lessons to enhance learning. Both faculty and students are encouraged to use ICT tools to improve engagement and effectiveness.

Key academic strategies include Comprehensive Continuous Evaluation, CBCS pattern, preparation of study material and question banks, mid-semester exams, remedial classes, student seminars, group discussions, quizzes, and field trips. Student progress is continuously monitored through the Internal Marks Register. The college has also implemented a mentor system to guide students and improve their academic performance, ensuring a holistic learning experience.

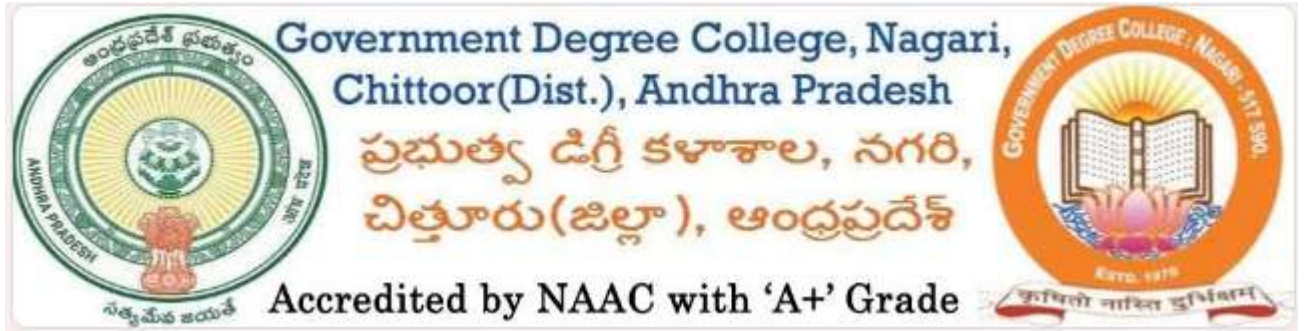

Field Trip Report

The Department of Economics of this institution conducted field trip on 23/3/2024 to Second BA students to study the ***Problems of Farmers' at the Fields*** at K. V. Puram village, nearly 12 KM from Nagari town. It is part of co-curricular activity to get a realistic understanding of situation by directly interacting with farmers.

Objectives

- To get the first hand information in a village on agriculture
- To study the conditions of farmers practically
- To know the cropping pattern of farmers
- To discuss with farmers on problems and remedies

Methodology

Interacted with the farmers at the field itself and get primary data and information. We prepared a questionnaire and asked framers directly to get data. We covered all types of farmers including large, medium and small scale farmers and also agricultural labourers.

Findings

In K.V. Puram Village majority farmers are cultivating commercial crops like sugar cane, mirchi and vegetables.

Following **problems** are identified by us on the interaction with farmers.

1. Unseasonal rainfall
2. High cost of inputs like seeds, fertilisers, pesticides
3. Frauds and fake brands in seeds and pesticides market
4. Lack of storage facilities near fields
5. Exploitation of the middlemen in the sales of produce
6. Gradual declining of ground water and lack of water under bore wells
7. Lack of better remunerative price for farmer's production

Finally majority opined that they could not continue this discouraging profession to their children in the future. They are trying for other alternative private jobs, businesses or self employment in the urban areas.

Solutions

Whenever we asked for remedies to their problems they responded with innovative ideas to solve them.

They should be treated with respect and just as passive beneficiaries. Instead of giving cash benefits per acre they thought it would be better to provide low cost inputs and quality seeds, equipments etc.

They prefer better remunerative prices for their produce to get reasonable income for their livelihood instead of pensions at the old age. They prefer to

use the latest tools like drones, crop cutting machines to improve their productivity.

If they want to continue this profession they demand not just farmer welfare but overall rural development which gives shelter to all types of people.

Students' response

As an economics students studying agriculture in the classroom, we found this field trip very useful and satisfactory. We learned all practically and get clarity. We are thankful to our Economics sir Mr. D.Ramanjulu
