

National Education Day on 10-11-2023

National Education Day (National level) **Minorities Welfare Day** (State level) is celebrated on 11th November of every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Minister of Education of independent India. **Dr. Bhaskara Raju**, in-charge principal informed that Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was the foremost among those who worked hard to lay foundations for education in independent India. Maulana Azad laid the foundations for the establishment of the University Grants Commission, the Indian Institute of Technologies (IITs), and the formulation of the secular education policy.

In recognition of his services in the freedom movement and independent India, he was given the Bharat Ratna award in 1954, but he humbly rejected it and said that if the people in power got it, it would be because of power and prestige.
